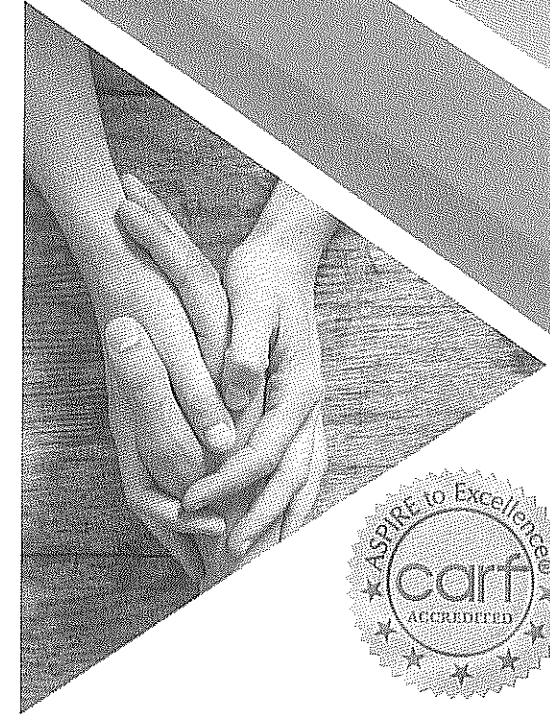

CMHC History and Programs

CMHC, Inc. was founded in 1978 by a group of doctors recognizing that there is a severe deficit of mental health services in most rural areas. They also realized that rural families require a specialized kind of service that integrates their culture, values and special needs into the services.

The comprehensive community mental health center is certified for all insurances and managed care companies operating in the region, Medicaid and Medicare, TriCare for military personnel and has a patient balance payment system.

Our facilities accept patients between 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, appointments arranged on Saturdays. We are on call 24 hours daily for emergency care.

Our prescribers are available for medication management and medical assessment each week.

From the south suburbs of Kansas City to the north suburbs of Joplin our centers are within easy driving access of patients wishing to avoid having to go into the city for services.

Medical Services

Medical Assisted Therapy: This is a multi-disciplinary intervention that includes behavioral health interventions for addiction. During the early phase of treatment, adding a medication which is a partial opiate agonist, helps the addicted patient tolerate the transition to sober functioning and growth in therapy.

Adherence, or "sticking in therapy until change occurs" is improved for many patients by adding a medication. Our program is staffed capable of doing this comprehensive treatment.

Our Medical staff perform assessment (histories and physicals), medication management and brief medical interventions with referrals for specialized and specialty medical services. Weekly appointments are available, and some will choose us as their healthcare home because their psychological services are their paramount concern. We offer neuropsychological assessment for competency, post stroke evaluation and cognitive rehabilitation and head injury. We have specialists in evaluating the 5 types of memory and declining cognitive abilities.

We offer treatment coordination and management of significant marital and family problems.
